Miodrag Lekić is the Member of the Parliament of Montenegro, President of the Committee for International Relations and Emigrants, President of the political party "DEMOS" and a diplomat. During his diplomatic career, Mr Lekic was the ambassador of the SFRJ in Mozambique, Lesotho, and Swaziland, the ambassador of the SRJ/SCG in Italy and Malta, and also the Minister of Foreign Affairs in the Government of Montenegro. Since 2004, he has been a professor at La Sapienza University in Rome, Faculty of Humanities, and since 2006 at Luis - Faculty of Political Sciences. In 2011, he was one of the founders and executive director of the NGO "Center for International Policy and European Integration - CEMP".

He has published several professional papers in the field of the history of international relations and diplomacy. For the book La mia guerra alla guerra (published by Guerini Associati, Milan) he received in 2007 the Italian award "Francesco Alziator" for the best book by a foreign author from the Mediterranean area published in Italian. The translation of the same book was published in Belgrade by the "Official Gazette" under the title *Moj rat protiv rata* (My war against the war). He is the author of the book *Istorija Italije* (History of Italy) in two volumes (publisher Daily press - Podgorica). He is the co-author of the books Dopo la pioggia (published by Argo - Lecce) and Italia e Montenegro (published by Laterza - Bari). In Italy, he published works in the magazines "Limes", "Affari internazionali" and "Lettera internazionale". He published comments and reviews in the Montenegrin newspapers "Dan" and "Vijesti" (cultural supplement "Art"), and in the Belgrade newspapers - "NIN" and "Politika"
